
- Increases the time it takes to process / interview applicants

- Increases Type 1 and Type 2 errors in hiring




Steps of a Substitute Teacher Pre-employment - Kicking the tires - Investigating Employment - Validate - Supporting and skills building - Specific Help


























Knowing Substitute Teachers

- 40% want a <u>permanent position</u> in your district










Effect

- Post training mentoring will help substitute teachers maintain a high level of self efficacy.














